The Board of Directors for Sugar Creek Homes Association recently implemented some new policies to help maintain the integrity of the community. Below is a brief synopsis of each policy. You can find each document in its entirety on our website at sugarcreekhomes.org.

Flags and Flagpoles

- Flags automatically approved are the US, Texas, and any branch of the US Armed Forces
- Flagpoles and lighting must be submitted to the ARC for approval
- Flags must be no larger than 3' X 5'
- All other flags must be submitted on a case-by-case basis

Only flags that are aesthetically pleasing, neighborly, and appropriate for our family-friendly neighborhood will be considered. An ARC approval for any such flag may be conditional.

Electric Vehicle Charging Stations (EVCS)

- Station must be installed by a licensed electrician
- EVCS must be wired and installed in accordance with manufacturer's guidelines and recommendations
- Owner must receive approval from the ARC for location of the EVCS prior to installation
- · Station may not be installed in public view
- All EVCS charging cords, when in use or otherwise, may not be in public view
- Lot owner may not charge others for the use of the EVCS


F.U.N. Grant Program

The City of Sugar Land, through the 4B Corporation, has partnered with community groups since 2002 to enhance the city's aesthetics.

Through partnerships with neighborhoods and community groups, the Fostering Unique Neighborhoods Grant Program aims to empower local entities like home owners associations (HOAs), property owners associations (POAs), and recognized community groups (RCGs) to revitalize and create distinctive spaces that embody the unique character of each neighborhood or commercial area. These collaborations foster economic development and workforce retention & attraction by leveraging placemaking, mobility enhancements, and beautification efforts to improve community quality of life.

This year, Sugar Creek was granted partnership on a crushed granite pathway through the center esplanades on Country Club Blvd. The pathways offer a safety solution for walkers and provide an aesthetic solution for areas where the grass will not grow.



You have probably heard about the upcoming changes to real estate by the National Association of Realtors. Here are the two key changes that go into effect August 17th.

- Every buyer represented by a
 Realtor is now required to sign a
 Buyer Representation Agreement
 formalizing the relationship
 between the buyer and broker
 before touring properties.
- Buyer's agent compensation can no longer be advertised on the MLS.
 Compensation has to be advertised, offered and negotiated outside of the MLS.








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Dulles Elementary Corner


