WHAT TO BRING?


Unneeded documents - There will be free document shredding for Sugar Creek residents, underwritten by your Sugar Creek Homes Association.

Sugar Creek's 2025 project

Sugar Land's F.U.N Grant Program has approved Sugar Creek's application for Phase II of the esplanade project on Country Club Blvd. The grant reimburses half of the project's cost. The project is set to begin this spring.





Reminders

Sugar Creek has an Electric Vehicle Charging Station (EVCS) policy in place. All charging stations must be installed out of view. Residents that wish to have their station outside of their garage must submit a request to the Architectural Committee for review. This policy can be found on our website.

All exterior improvements to your home must be submitted to the Architectural Committee for approval. This includes windows, landscaping design, back patios and storage, driveways, and roofs. The committee reviews requests on Thursdays, and, although the committee has 30 days to respond, most applications are handled within two weeks. 




